



## YLA Crochet Along Part 2

It is time for part 2 of the YLA Crochet Along Four Seasons! In this part we will finish the first two circles. Are you ready? Let's begin. Don't forget: it is important to read everything very carefully. ☺

### Materials:

- [YLA CAL yarn pack](#), with 15 skeins Caron or 15 skeins Stylecraft. The kit contains 11 colours, 4 skeins are of the main colour.
- Hook 5mm or US H/8 (Caron), or hook 4mm or US G/6 (Stylecraft,) or the hook size needed to obtain the right gauge
- Stitch markers
- Scissors
- Tapestry needle to weave in ends

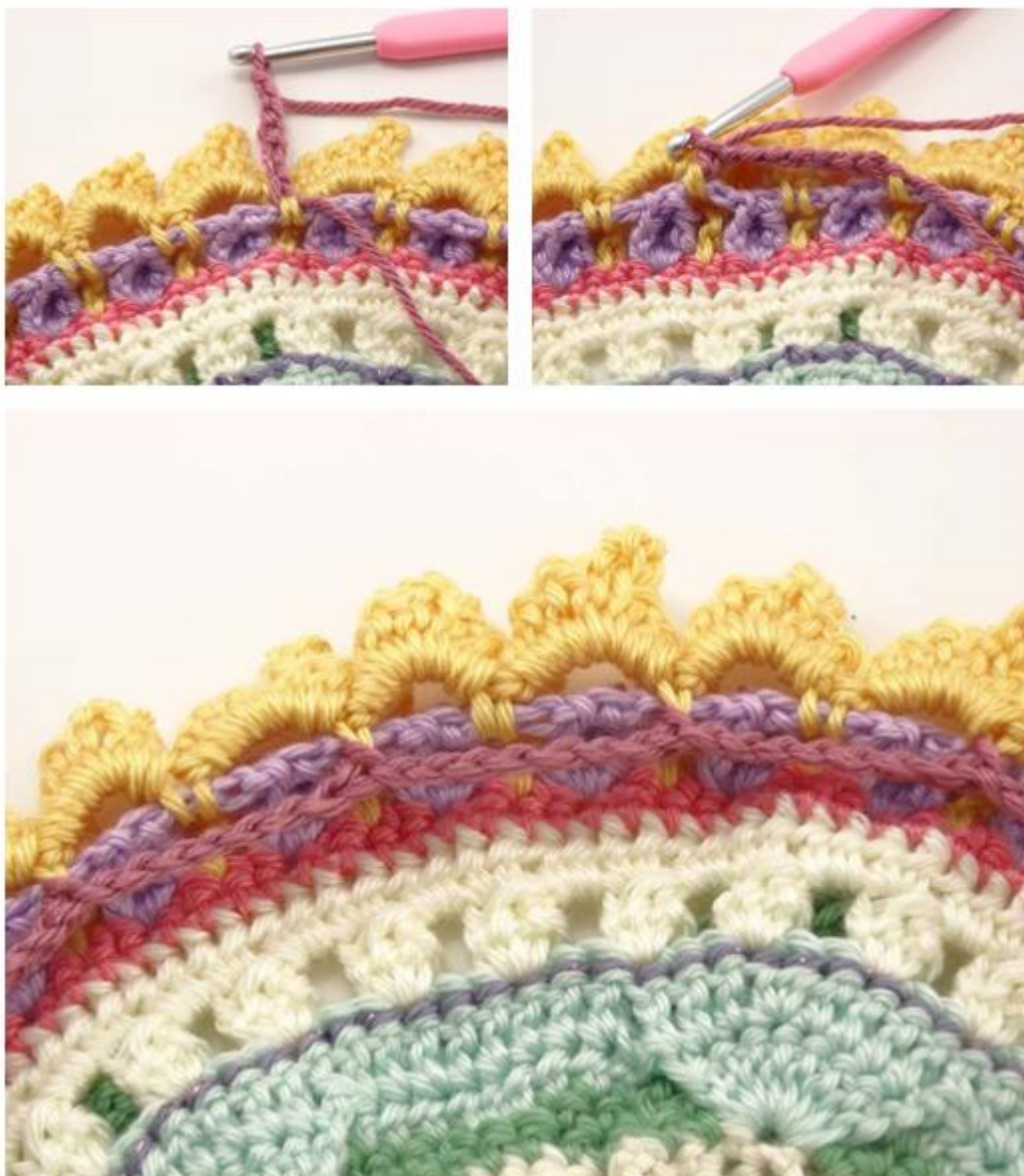
## Pattern circle 1.2

In this part we will work rounds 21 t/m 33 of the first circle.

**ATTENTION:** *make this circle twice!*

**Round 21:** work with back side facing, join around the base of any skipped sc of round 19 (see photo), ch 8 (first ch counts as sc), \*skip 1 skipped sc, 1 sc in the next skipped sc, ch 7, repeat from \* until the end, join to the first beginning ch, do not fasten off. (18 ch sp)

**Attention:** *the rows of chains will pull in a bit, but don't worry, this will straighten out in the next round.*





**Round 22:** right side facing, sl st to the next ch sp, ch 4 (counts as 1 tr), 8 tr in ch sp, 1 tr in the next sc between the 2 ch sp, \*9 tr in next ch sp, 1 tr in the next sc between the 2 ch sp, repeat from \* until the end, join with sl st to the beginning ch-4, do not fasten off. (180 st)



**Round 23:** ch 2 (counts as 1 hdc), 1 hdc in every st until the end, join with sl st, fasten off. (180 st)



**Round 24:** join in any st of the previous round and work ch 3 (counts as 1 sc + ch 2), skip 2 st, \*1 sc in the next st, ch 2, skip 2 st, repeat from \* until the end, join with sl st to the beginning ch-1, fasten off. (60 sc & 60 ch sp)

*Your work will pull in a bit again, don't worry, this will straighten out once again in the next round.*



**Round 25:** join in any ch sp of the previous round and work ch 3 (counts as 1 dc), 2 dc in the same ch sp, ch 1, \*3 dc in the next ch sp, ch 1, repeat from \* until the end, join with sl st to the beginning ch-3, fasten off. (60 3-dc groups)



**Round 26:** join in any ch sp of the previous round and work ch 3 (counts as 1 dc), [1 dc, 1 tr, 2 dc] in the same ch sp, 1 fpdtr around the base of the hdc, which falls under the sc in round 24 – if you are right-handed this stitch will be just to the right of the sc, if you are left-handed it will be to the left of the sc -- (see photo), ch 3, skip 3 dc + 1 ch sp + the next 3 dc of the last round, \*1 fpdtr around the base of the hdc falling under the sc in round 24, [2 dc, 1 tr, 2 dc] in the next ch sp, 1 fpdtr round the same st as your previous fpdtr, ch 3, skip 3 dc + 1 ch sp + the next 3 dc of the last round, repeat from \* until the end, finish with 1 fpdtr around the same st as your first fpdtr, join with a sl st to the beginning ch-3, fasten off. (30 fans)

**Round 27:** join in any ch sp between 2 fans of the previous round and work ch 1 (counts as 1 sc), 3 sc in the same ch sp, ch 2 (these fall behind the fans of the last round), \*4 sc in the next ch sp, ch 2, repeat from \* until the end, join with a sl st to the beginning ch-1, do not fasten off. (120 sc & 30 ch sp)



**Round 28:** ch 3 (counts as 1 dc), 3 dc, 4 dc in the next ch sp, \*4 dc, 4 dc in the next ch sp, repeat from \* until the end, join with sl st to the beginning ch-3, fasten off (240 st)



**Round 29:** join in any first dc of a 4-dc group behind a fan of a previous round and work ch 2 (counts as 1 sc), 5 sc, 1 tr in the ch sp of round 25, skip 1 sc (falls behind your tr), \*7 sc, 1 tr in ch sp, skip 1 sc, repeat from \* until the end, join with sl st to the beginning ch-2, fasten off. (240 st)







**Round 30:** join in any tr of the last round and work ch 4 (counts as 1 sc + ch 3), skip 3 st, \*1 sc in next st, ch 3, skip 3 st, repeat from \* until the end, join with sl st to beginning ch-1, fasten off. (60 sc & 60 ch sp)



**Round 31:** join in any ch sp of the last round and work ch 3 (counts as 1 dc), 3 dc in the same ch sp, 4 dc in every ch sp until the end, join with sl st to the beginning ch-3, fasten off. (60 4-dc groups)





**Round 32:** join in any st of the last round and work ch 2 (counts as 1 sc), work 1 sc in every st until the end, join with sl st to the beginning ch-2, do not fasten off. (240 st)



**Round 33:** ch 2 (counts as 1 sc), 239 sc, join with sl st, fasten off (240 st)

*The diameter of your circle should measure about 52 cm (20.5 inches)*
